This is what I ordered last year:

- \*2-114oz Ketchup containers (for the pumps)
- \*1- 104oz Mustard container “ “
- \*2-54 pk Air Head Extremes (should have ordered 6 units-boys favorites)
- \*1-36 pk Hershey Bars
- \*1-36 pk Kit Kat Bars
- \*1-24 pk Milk Duds (wouldn't get them again-sold well, but hard to keep at the right temp-someone put them in the fridge and they got "wet", if left out them might melt)
- \*1-36 pk Reese Cups (could use more)
- \*1-36pk Twizzlers

I also ordered a few things that I wouldn't order again, as you might guess Cow Tales tops the list! Also, I bought a few off brand names items and found the off brands don't interest the kids!

Sam's Club:

- \*Chip-small bags include, Fritos for walking tacos
- \*Ground Beef-They sell a large quantity a tube, I asked why the tube are so much cheaper, they said quantity is more than other packages and also they **don't** add "color" to the meat, so it looks a little less yummy (does raw meat ever looks yummy), so the price is much less.
- \*Paper product-napkins, plates, cups and lids, foil wraps for dogs
- \*Buns, (burgers and dogs as needed)
- \*Pickles and Relish
- \*Sour Cream, Lettuce, Tomatoes, cheese
- \*Hot Cocoa
- \*Popcorn

Gordon's Food Service:

You can get most things at Sam's, but I did use Gordon's a fair amount for anything and everything I got at Sam's mostly when I was in a hurry, just easier in and out at Gordon's. Tell them you are getting it for PN soccer and it will be tax exempt at Gordon. We found that Sam's has better pricing in most cases.

#### A-1 Signs:

They will change the menu for a \$5 fee, they just lift the letters or numbers off and make corrections. They are on Winter's Drive right off Portage Road by the airport. Rich, the owner, has done the signs for years.

FYI: only use the wipe off pens on the lower portion of the menu, the top isn't meant to have those pens used on it, I know I tried, it was a mess!

#### Meijer:

They donate between \$100-200 per season. Contact Candy Hook at the Westnedge store at [Candace.Hook@meijer.com](mailto:Candace.Hook@meijer.com) The earlier you contact her, the better, she can sometimes donate twice in one season if you get to her early. You will need PN Soccer's tax number which you can get from ScottVanderSloot, then just fill out the donation form that you can get at the service desk at the Westnedge Meijer'
